This organization has touched the lives of thousands of locals and tourists with the many events and activities over the past years.

During the past year, Young and old runners participated in the Lake Russell Hustle which produce championships in various age categories. Some walking, some pushing babies, some running. Hope South provided the resources to make this a great family oriented spring event that brought recognition to the outdoors and the need for healthy outlets of discovery. Sponsors made it healthy with bananas, water and apples.

Lake Russell is being discovered as a mecca for paddling and boating. Our Paddle Fest has brought much attention to the beauty of Lake Russell and her unspoiled shoreline. Many attend our Paddle event, but most noticeable is the proliferation of Kayaks, Canoes, and watercraft of the visitors to our area. We now have an outlet for rental of Kayaks from either LRRTC or a local vendor.

What could give any more pleasure to a parent, guardian, or kid than to either see the action or actually catch their first fish. Hundreds of kids flocked to Lake Russell for over 25 years to catch fish



provided by the State of South Carolina in a Corps of Engineers provided fishing event. LRRTC depends on generous donors and sponsors in support of our events and goals. We, however, pitch in and do our part in raising volunteer funds to help out. Many teams participated in our LRRTC golf outing which gave much attention to our events and involved many in supporting our efforts. Similarly, we held a Chili supper fund raiser that brought many to eat in or take-home chili to help us fund our efforts. The beauty of these LRRTC fundraising events is that it promotes family and friends in community support activities. Some of this past year's activities that involved LRRTC were the Town Wide Eggstravaganza Easter Egg Hunt, the famous Calhoun Falls Town Wide Yard Sale, and the support of our local schools by providing a scholarship for an FFA student to a summer outdoor camp. A special action this year was to further our environmental involvement with SCDOT Adopt a Highway Litter Pick up.

One of, if not the largest, displays of evening fireworks over Lake Russell brings these folks to the shores but also is a venue to hundreds of boaters that come from all over the lake to see this beautiful sight. Fall is a hunting and fishing prime season each year in the Lake Russell and Abbeville area and fall is in the air everywhere with our fall JUBILEE.
